#### 1. We now offer "test optional" Admission.

Students who choose to apply as "test optional" will take part in a holistic evaluation with their Admissions Counselor. Based on this review, students will receive an Acceptance or a Conditional Acceptance.

A Conditional Acceptance will require students to take six hours of college coursework during the summer term to demonstrate their college readiness. These classes can be taken at any institution, however we offer these courses at a reduced rate for this purpose.

#### 2. We now accept ACT Superscores.

LWC will now be using ACT Superscores for admissions purposes and scholarship offerings.

#### 3. We have increased our scholarship offerings. The updated Academic Scholarship awards are listed below.

## **2021 GOVERNOR'S SCHOOL FRO ENTREPRENEURS (GSE)**

Dates have been announced for the 2021 Governor's School for Entrepreneurs (GSE).

The 2020 GSE was held online due to COVID-19, but the 2021 iteration is set to take place in person June 6-26 on Northern Kentucky University's campus.

Applications will be accepted starting Nov. 16. The summer event is open to current Kentucky students in grades 9-11.

In preparation for the application period, more <u>virtual events will be held on Hopin to inform</u> prospective GSE applicants and their families.

They will take place Nov 19, Dec. 9 and Dec. 16. All of the hour-long sessions start at 4 p.m. ET. Since 2013, GSE has taught entrepreneurial skills to teens from around Kentucky. Participants can develop a network of mentors and fellow entrepreneurs. Eleven businesses have been started by GSE alumni, while other alumni have filed for patents.

Participants can qualify for \$3 million in scholarships at Kentucky colleges and universities. More information is available at the <u>Kentucky GSE website</u>.

### RISE APPLICATION LAUNCHES NOVEMBER 16<sup>TH</sup>

We're writing to you with big news.
